- Matthew 28:20 Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.
- John 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
- John 14:1-3 Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion? - Just look at the Beatitudes: mourn, peacemakers, persecution...
- Passages on suffering:

And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. 1 Peter 5:10 Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope.

Abraham's life 2


- New covenant with God which requires circumcision and name changes
- Angels visit and tell that Sarah will have a son
- Abraham intercedes for Sodom
- Sodom is destroyed
- Again Abraham pretends that Sarah is his sister and is caught out
- Isaac is born and Hagar and Ishmael are sent away
- God commands Abraham to sacrifice Isaac to Him and he sets out to do so.
- Sarah dies, after some time Abraham marries for the 3rd time and has 6 sons
