As you will know, from last Sunday you no longer need to book a seat in church. Following a rearrangement of the seating layout (in line with current guidance) capacity has been increased. This worked well and there was plenty of room for everybody wishing to attend church in person. 'Thank you' to those who are willing to assist with stewarding as we move forward with this arrangement.

To enable those less able and our new church family members to have a seat inside, we hope that some will be willing to give up a seat inside if things get busy and sit outside on seats provided, near the west door where there is a loudspeaker.

Stewards will direct you to a seat and you will be asked for your name for track and trace. If you are planning to come and sit within a 'bubble' please arrive at the same time, this will help our stewards!

Holy Communion on a Wednesday

Revive Newport - June Prayer Letter

Dear Prayer Partners,

It is no wonder they call this month 'Blooming June'! It really does feel as everything that had been previously hidden or unseen suddenly bursts forth - flowers, seeds, fruit trees, vegetables - all coming to life, with promise of even more good things to come as a result.

It always makes me think of *Ecclesiastes Chapter 3*, "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven," and it really does feel that this is a new season of activity starting, a time when things that have been held back will start to burst forth and bloom and bring forth fruit.

I really feel this is true for the work of Revive, and you can certainly feel from Pete that he feels the same, as you read his prayer points for this month!

First of all, Praise God that we have been able to open the doors of The Living Room to customers and for Newport Youth Cafe young people.

It has been great to see people in person, old and new customers, and meet up with the young people that we have been working with on line over the last 14 months. Thank God for the teams that have been working to make this all happen and help more people.

The Living Room Now we are up and running, please pray that we will get the custom we need to make this work financially, as well as having the opportunities to listen to people, show support and value to them, and spread the love of Jesus to all who come through the doors.

Newport Youth Café All our young people are now in the older group (yr 12+) and they have been bringing along their friends, so we are already at full capacity for numbers for the second sessions (6-7.30 pm). However, we have no one now in the younger group (yr 9-11) for the earlier sessions (4-5.30 pm). We have been chatting to plenty of younger ones in the bus station, so please pray that they will be drawn to come and find out more.

A New Building! As you can tell, bringing everything together at TLR is working well at the moment, but being in the centre of town could mean that we run out of space fast, so having a building big enough to accommodate the growing need among the young age groups in our town would be such a blessing. Please pray for wisdom, guidance, and the release of finance for this need.

Communication As we have mentioned before, we have the privilege of helping lots of people in many ways, but are not very good at communicating this to help people understand and know the good work that is going on. So we would like to improve communication to help awareness of

all that the Church as a whole is doing, help raise financial backing, and ultimately see the Church as a centre point in our town. We are experiencing a lot of additional need at the present time right across the world, and the Church is the only organisation that has all the resources to meet those needs. I would love to see us all step up even more with a "Here I am - how can I help?" mentality, and as a result see people helped, and to ultimately find Jesus, as we put Him on a stand (not under a bowl), in everything that we do.

Two ways that could help us achieve this, are:

1. *Alpha Courses* - I think that online Alpha is going to be key to change, so pray that we can work together to get this set up and rolling, ideally as an ongoing thing.

2. *Acts of Kindness* - We would like to develop a team of people to start going out into the town and doing acts of kindness to bless people, as a witness to the love of God. Please pray into these two initiatives.

Prayer As you are aware, dear Prayer Partners, prayer is the key to everything that we do, and is always a key component to any move of God - which is what we want! To this end, we will be making prayer even more key this year, and part of this is to turn the room at the top of the stairs at the Living Room into a prayer room. We will be set up soon and we will be looking for volunteers to pray for all this work there. Please contact Pete if you are interested in being a part of this, and would like more information.

We would not have got to where we are now without the prayer support and faithfulness over the years of you, our prayer warriors. As always, we pray that each one of you will be blessed in your lives, and that you, along side Revive, will see the fruit of your endeavours in prayer during this new season.
