As we start to build on our existing team of those working with and helping and look forward to the future, we're looking for support volunteers to enable Sunday and midweek children's groups to happen.

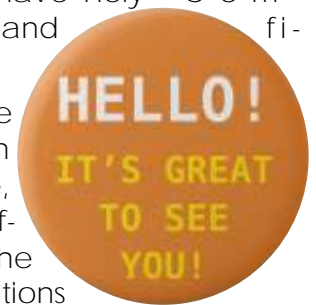
If you have recently been helping or you'd like to join that team to serve then please speak to Dozie Andrew or Josephine.

### Deanery Synod 17.06.21 at the Minster

Kevin, Dozie & Andrew attended a 'mixed' meeting - that was both in person and on Zoom at the same time. The main speaker for the evening was the new Area Dean for the Island Rev. Steve Daughtery who is the Vicar at Holy Trinity Bembridge. He updated us on the IW Deanery Plan that had been previously rejected by the Diocese. In brief, he suggested that the case for large scale amalgamation of parishes is perhaps not yet proven and has offered a trial feasibility study in the Ryde area. An interesting and overall encouraging meeting!
